Now we know we're down \$371,000 — that is our maximum loss. We had another enrollment count Monday, Added 2 add'l students. No one has lost job, no rifting. When we look at financial position for coming school year we look at what positions are needed and move forward from there. Theresa — positions that didn't return this year are not "lost" positions Nancy, those people weren't returning, so I looked at them as positions that wouldn't have been filled. lTheresa — what about the RtI staff? Nancy — they are available, but we are unable to pay them now. Toni — some are receiving unemployment. Nancy — they can draw unemployment, but I can't pay them until students return. Carriel -- we all collaborated together, such a good group, not fully sure what the role encompassed. Bruce -- pretly much keep meeting going.

Nancy has sent all notes, was sent out as a .pdf. Not a lot has changed. Biggest change: In Learning at Home through this semester. Superintendent looking for students to return to campus in January. Question: How to bring children back safely? How many to bring back? WHO are the vulnerable students and how to bring them back. Theresa -- I thought we already have vulnerable students on-campus? Nancy -- we have about 20 now -- they have IEPs and their objectives cannot be met when not on-campus. Theresa -- so we have some vulnerable students on campus; are looking to determine WHO else should we look at as vulnerable and need to return to campus? DOE says vulnerable students need to return to campus, but hasn't defined "vulnerable". Nancy -- goal is to bring smaller groups of children to school, begin teaching rituals and routines re: social distance and masks ... and continue slowly build number on campus. Bruce -- is there a methodology to determine who and how? Theresa -- can we say we're ahead of the game because we have the students are on campus now? Vulnerable students are on campus ... Nancy -- I believe "yes", now we have 20 students of about 800. 350 of the 800 are full distance; so, how do we address needs of the other 450? Benefit of having more than adults on campus ... gradually build flexibility or recognition of more people on campus as we build capacity. Our biggest challenge now: how to provide lunch and recess? Maintain social distance during these less structured times ... Recommendation is to build to having more students on the campus, to eventually have students on campus for the "AABB" (blended)

rotation. Bob -- feasible for this school year? Nancy -- depends on DOH metrics as well as campus thinking on the matter. Bob -- the logistics of this sounds overwhelming, as does the confusion related~ Bruce -- focus maybe on what is needed to ramp-up to target number. We do need to start with rational number, work out the kinks ... overwhelming if we start too large. Nancy -- we have plans in place for many boints you mentioned -- one part of day not vet solidified is "recess". Concern now: "ohana""/"Bubble" -- keeping kids within their assigned classes .... Next question ... ves. bring students in slowly ... which students? Bob -shorter time they are at school each day is lesser need for recess.

Toni -- thoughts re: transition back ... maybe Wednesdays? Maybe some EL kids with greater need? Nancy -- a transition, we've not been told it is students, not specific "classes". Carriel asked about PPE ... Nancy -- we have a good inventory of PPE. Carriel -- what about cleaning on campus? My concern yesterday was it seems like we're jumping around, not addressing concerns in workable manner. Not sure how "picking and choosing" who comes back will work ...

Jeanne -- concern: sanitation during and after the school day. Nancy -- looks like it was a miscommunication; Has spoken with staff involved.

Theresa -- in terms of alakai'i -- potentially escorting students about campus ... no masks? 6 feet apart protocol, Pohai working on backpacks with items kids can use independently during recess -- spoke with Kelly -- she gave a couple of links online for elementary students (relay races kine activity). If alakai'i are there to accompany students at unstructured times, how will that look? Training can be useful. If kids are growing up in a world that needs 6' apart, we need to help them learn how to live with the new expectations

Michelle -- determining vulnerable, small groupings, maybe bringing younger students first (perhaps more vulnerable, as need more teaching). Nancy -- many ways to look at this, which makes it more challenging.

Toni -- some discussion of Kahakai model.

Dona -- Kealakehe -- part of concern is size!

Maybe look online for mainland schools to see what they are doing.

Nancy -- latest request from Superintendent is what we've been discussing.

Toni -- any updates on state employee furloughs? Nancy -- not yet.

Nancy -- always looking for additional members, hopefully another parent or 2!

Carriel is going to try to stay with us through the times ahead.
