Updates

Distance Learning teachers have been busy getting to know their new students and saying goodbye to students who switched to Blended Learning.

All students who switched to Distance Learning started their Acellus classes at the 50% progress mark.

DL students are now required to complete Kumu Duell's physical education assignments.

There are a number of students who have completed all their Acellus courses, particularly in the lower grades. These students will be given alternative work such as i-Ready, Acellus enrichment courses, Achieve 3000, and Generation Genius.



Highlights

- 60%-72% of our students are meeting their progress goals in Acellus. Teachers are working with those that are not.
- One of our teachers has been working with a student going through the SFT process. Although providing an intervention virtually and collecting data is challenging, it has ultimately been successful.
- Another of our teachers is working with a student and her mom in a small group. This way, mom can reinforce lessons at home.
