Dear Faculty, Staff, and Parents/Guardians:

In 1989 Congress passed the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). Under this Act, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) requires our school to notify parents, teachers, and staff of the presence and status of asbestos containing materials in our school buildings. The law further requires a management plan to be maintained at the school based upon findings of an initial inspection.

We have completed the required six months surveillance on June 30, 2017 and will complete the next in December of 2017.

The results of the recently completed surveillance indicate there have been no changes in the condition of the asbestos containing materials in our school buildings. A copy of the management plan is on file in the administration office and is available for your review during regular school hours.
