<p>Review of Bylaws</p>	<p>Edits Suggested</p> <p>-<u>Article XIII</u> add sentence to section 1 to end the paragraph : "A meeting notice and agenda must be posted in public location at the school and on the school website...6 days prior to meeting." -<u>Article V Section 1b and d</u> - will change to at least 1 parent and 1 teacher -<u>Article V Section 2</u> - header should be "Nominations, Elections, and Term" and include a text that describes protocol for nomination, after this add text that states that if there is only one candidate for nomination no ballot will be required (solicited in the 4th quarter with a notice in the school newsletter, school website...) -<u>Article V Section 2e</u> - change ...make last sentence the first sentence ("Student representation will be optional."); also, change "Student representative is...to may...be selected..." Article XIII Section 4 - quorum will defined as at least one member of the core representation -Change the 2nd Article VIII to Article IX -Pages of Bylaws will be numbered</p>
