Gave history of Meet and Eat: community organization; started in this community to target single parent families; five community organizations involved; these organization bring entree meal, and they provide support staff; Ardie provides sides and desserts; McDonalds provides paper goods; KTA provides baked goods</li><li>4. In 23 years, only one Weds was missed (there was a hurricane)</li><li>5. Marshall Akamu can provide USDA food to cook for .18/lb</li><li>6. The cost of this program is about \$2500/year; 8,000 meals/year</li><li>7. A Cassidy proposed that we ask our community if they are interested in helping to make this a reality in our school</li><li>8. Huge responsibility for anyone who decides to take over</li><li>9.
